



## NHS Highland Third Sector Funding From 1 April 2025

NHS Highland is seeking applications from third sector and community groups who can help to deliver services, projects and activities against its priorities to achieve better outcomes for adults (over the age of 18) living in Highland.

Developed in consultation with the third sector in April and May 2024 the following priorities are at the core of what NHS Highland is hoping to achieve through its commissioning process.

- **Living Well:** People living with a long term condition are supported to better take control of their own health and wellbeing and have access to activity, services and support that enables them to live well and stay well.
- **Staying Well:** People living in our communities, particularly older people, are supported to live well, more independently and at home for longer.
- **Value Well:** People in Highland who act as an unpaid carer for a loved one are valued, able to collaborate in a way that recognises their experience and that they have support to help them have positive experiences and feel recognised.

A single application process will open on 15 July 2024 and will close on 15 August 2024, with funding available as follows:

- 1 April 2025 – up to a maximum of 3 years and no more than £49,999 per annum.
- Activities that support adults (over the age of 18) living in Highland.
- Activities should be able to deliver against one or more of the above priorities.
