You will need good written and verbal communication skills, and you will be computer-literate.


In addition, you will:

- Environment: we aim to protect our environment through developing sustainable working practices, continued restoration and maintenance of green spaces and promotion of ecological awareness.


Viewfield Garden Collective is a UK charity relying on income from our produce, public donations and grant funding to deliver our work.
